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- Multiple answer questions are a pitfall
- Status on parent Haiku accounts
 - Almost there!
- Brainstorm on Chromebooks at the end of the school year
 - Seniors-Turn in at checkout? Work with admin. (All call for help)
 - Freshman- Check out device at success camps? First week of school for others?
 - Continuing Students-
 - Jed- we should have students pass a digital citizenship course to prove that they can responsibly use the device over the Summer.
 - David Sanchez- incentivize using attendance as one of the requirements to use the Chromebook over the summer.
 - Princess- is there any way we can limit who can take them home? There are some situations where it wouldn't work out. Joe- most likely a small percentage in that situation. Shouldn't worry about breaking devices. It is a tool that should be used and eventually worn out. Princess- her experience is that a significant amount (maybe 40%?) of students will abuse their Chromebooks over the summer. More investigation needs to be done.
 - Jed - for students accessing the network over the summer: what effect will this have on the network and/or infrastructure over the summer?
 - will IT dept. still be able to support technical issues?
 - What will a student do if they have a technical problem?
 - set up appointment schedule for support issues
 - How much does it cost to check in, store and check back out 8,000 Chromebooks over the summer.
