**1. *Call to Order:***

Vice-Chair Sheila Curtis called the meeting to order at 4:17 p.m.

**2. *Roll Call:***

Brenna Dorado conducted a roll call of Committee Members and indicated that a quorum was established. 4 members were present; 3 were absent.

**3. *Pledge of Allegiance:***

Ms. Curtis led the Committee in reciting the Pledge of Allegiance.

**4. *Public Comment:***

There were no public comments.

**5. Adopt Meeting Minutes: 9/28/2021**

Joshua Naggart motioned to approve the Minutes from the last meeting on 09/28/2021 as presented; George Mills seconded the motion. No opposition. Motion carried.

**6. COC Membership Terms:** COC Bylaws allow committee members to serve two 3 year terms. The first term will end on May 19, 2022. All members present expressed interest in serving a second term. Brenna Dorado and Candace Reines will contact the absent members to find out if they are interested in serving a second term.

**7. Bond Expenditure Report:**

Xochitl Molina summarized the Expenditure Reports and asked the committee members if they had any questions or concerns. No questions were posed.

**8. Annual Report Provided**

The Annual Report was provided to members for review and summarization. Ms. Reines referred to the audit findings on page 22 and advised that there were no audit findings or adjustments.

**9. Presentation/Discussion on School District Facilities Projects:**

Chad Goodwin presented updates on the following facility projects:

CMI - The Grand Opening Ceremony was September 29, 2021. New fencing was added to the south parking lot for storing site vehicles. A new flagpole was installed near portables for parade ceremonies on the field. The covered walkway between the gym and the E building still needs to be completed.

PHS - Pool demolition is tentatively scheduled to begin during summer 2022 with a projected completion date of spring 2023. Roofing of the administration building is set to begin this week. The theater building masonry is complete and structural work is ongoing. Agricultural Mechanics is on its fifth concrete masonry unit lift. Heating has been installed in the barn.

PVHS - The design of the campus reconfiguration and additions is almost complete. It is estimated to be a 24-36 month-long project once construction begins. DSA approval is expected in late 2022. Upcoming projects include relocating administration functions to a new building, improvements to campus security, and the creation of a new school entrance. A multipurpose room will be created in the area where the existing "L" buildings currently sit. The old administrative offices will be repurposed as a student union facility. Pool construction began in May 2021 and should be completed by the end of summer 2022.

HHS - Pool construction is underway and the pool bottom concrete has been placed. Underground utilities to the project have been completed. The aquatic center should be completed by the end of summer 2022.

LHS - The pool has been filled and the heater turned on.

**10. Other Updates by the District or Consultants:**

There were no additional updates.

**11. Designation of Next Meeting Date:**

It was established that the next COC meeting date will be Tuesday, April 5, 2022, at Paloma Valley High School.

**12. Comments:**

Ms. Curtis stated that Perris Union High School District is setting the pace on what high schools should be.

**13. Adjournment:**

Mr. Mills motioned to adjourn the meeting; Marilee Menez seconded the motion. No opposition. Motion carried.
